

Lois Pruett Williams Scholarship University United Methodist Church

The Lois Pruett Williams Scholarship was created in honor and remembrance of Lois Pruett Williams. The aim of the Lois Pruett Williams Educational Scholarship Trust is to provide financial assistance for the parent or parents who find it difficult to provide funds for the tuition to enroll their child or children in the University United Methodist Church's Child Development Center.

Eligibility

- Applicant must provide evidence of enrollment or acceptance by the University Child Development Center
- Applicant may be a Member or non-member of UUMC.

Scholarship Considerations

- Scholarship will be awarded on the basis of need.
- Preference will be given to single parents.

Application Process

- Complete the Lois Pruett Williams Scholarship application by **June 1** for Fall applications and **January 1** for Spring applications.
- Submit two letters of recommendation. If reapplying, new letters of recommendation are required annually.
- Submit an essay of 250 words relative to future plans and goals. If reapplying, a new essay is required annually.
